EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

ENTRIES CLOSE MAY 1, 2008. *Entries POSTMARKED after MAY 1, 2008 will be charged a late fee of \$30.00 per horse.* Entry, drug and stall fees must be paid in full at the time of entry and accompany entry blanks. Post entries must be made one session prior to the class being entered.

ENTRIES The term "Entry" may not be used when an owner qualifies more than one horse in a Championship class. Enter one horse which might be shown and you may make a substitution with another qualified entry at no charge.

Championship Qualifications - Exhibitors must enter and show in the respective Section for each championship.

All entries in ladies classes will be eligible to show back in their respective Amateur Championship, if qualified by an Amateur

FXED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Cross entering is allowed between the Classic Pleasure and English Pleasure Divisions and Classic Pleasure Driving and Pleasure Driving Divisions, if shoeing requirements are met.

ENTRY FEES *Classes \$30.00./ Championships & Stakes \$50.00*

EXCEPTION - UPHA Classic - Entry fee is \$100

USEF Fee - Every horse participating shall pay a \$12 Federation fee (\$7 shall be an equine drugs and medication fee).

NON-SHOWING HORSE FEE There is a \$50 charge per horse for horses that are not entered and shown in any classes.

FOOTING The coliseum show arena is 100' x 200' and is DIRT FOOTING. The outside warm up rings are DIRT FOOTING.. Carriage is GRASS FOOTING.. Dressage is SAND FOOTING.

SCRATCHES An exhibitor failing to scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the session in which the class is scheduled will be assessed a \$25.00 scratch fee. All scratches must be made on the official scratch form and signed by the Secretary.

BILLING FEE A \$25.00 Fee will be charged to any Exhibitor/Farm who must be billed after the show.

REFUNDS Refund request made before the closing date of entries, May 1, 2008, will be made in full. Entry fees will be refunded due to a casualty to a horse or exhibitor, or an immediate member of the exhibitor's family **ONLY** when the exhibitor provides the Show Secretary with a veterinarian or doctor's certificate no later than the start of the show. ***STALL FEES and OFFICE FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED FOR ANY REASON AFTER MAY 1, 2008, THE CLOSE OF ENTRIES.***

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS The Massachusetts Department of Public Health requires that all horses must have a copy of a negative Coggins Test for EIA dated within 6 months of the date of the show for out of state horses, 24 months for Massachusetts horses. A veterinarian health certificate is suggested for all out of state horses.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE The grounds will be open to exhibitors and horses at **8:00 a.m., MONDAY, JUNE 2, 2008** until SUNDAY, June 8, 2008.

STABLING 620 permanent stalls with doors are available. Show Management cannot guarantee the same stall location from year to year. There will be no additional stabling. Due to the stabling limitations, early entries are advised. **NO INITIAL BEDDING.**

BOX SEATS Will be available during the entire course of the show at the rate of \$ 100.00.

CAMPERS & HORSE TRAILERS USED AS LIVING QUARTERS Will be parked in designated areas. Camper stickers will be issued at the gate by Eastern States. The fee is \$ 235.00 . **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Fees are paid at the show office.

Early Arrival - Campers can move in on Friday, May 30, 2008, Saturday, May 31, 2008 and/or Sunday, June 1, 2008, but must pay a \$15 per night early arrival fee at the gate.

LUNGING of horses is not permitted in the Coliseum.

QUIET TIME will be in the Coliseum from 8:30-9:30 AM each morning.

FIRE & SAFETY REGULATIONS The following regulations must be adhered to in accordance with the Town of West Springfield Fire Regulations and Public Safety Code.

1. **No smoking allowed in barns or coliseum. Strictly enforced.**

2. No open flames allowed in any building.

3. All fabrics used as backdrops and/or display must be flame retardant.

4. Burlap material is not allowed for display.

5. Bark mulch is not allowed for display material.

Large Wood chips or coarse bark mulch may be used IN BARNs but shall be kept damp at all times.

6. No motorized gasoline/diesel vehicles.

7. All exits and fire lanes shall remain free and clear at all times.

8. No excessive accumulation of litter or rubbish.

9. All aisles shall be a minimum of 10' in length.

Aisle Displays widths are not to exceed:

Main aisles 30" from each side

Side aisles 24" from each side

10. All children 12 years of age and under must wear a helmet while riding a bicycle,

11. No roller blading or skate boarding.

12. No glass bottles or containers.

All Open, Junior Horse and Classic Championships will be stripped.

UPHA CLASSICS \$250 ADDED The entry fee for the class is \$100 A non-refundable \$50 eligibility fee must be paid to UPHA by April 1st of each year. After April 1st the fee becomes \$100. The first declaration fee is \$50 and must be made by May 1, 2008. The second payment, the Starting Fee, is also \$50 and is due 24 hours prior to the class.

All monies collected in each Classic will be dispersed in that class. Prize money is divided as follows: \$150 is deducted from the total, with \$50 going to fourth, fifth and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid to first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there were only 2 entries, the total prize money would be split 60% and 40%. If only 3 entries show, the total prize money the original percentages would apply, without the \$300 deduction. In case of only one entry, that entry would receive 100% of the total.
